Comments:

Conditions for summer fell racing were favourable considering the impending heat wave and forecast weather, skies were overcast with a relatively cooling southerly breeze. The Viking Chase fourth counter in the Dave Parry Lets Run Summer Fell Race Series 2022 returning after a two year covid hiatus welcomed 72 competitors to the start line, for the 12.8km course with four main climbs and the undulating return leg amounting to 500 metres plus of ascent.

With marshalls provided by the Cleveland Mountain Rescue Team in position, the runners were off at 10:48hrs. It was a Harry Holmes Matlock AC who led out and quickly gained an early lead by the top of Carlton Bank the first climb of the race.

First of the steeplechasers was Thomas Naisby Esk Valley Fell Club (4th overall) who hurdled the stile at the base of Carlton Bank and passed two runners in the manoeuvre, a number of other followed suit, a trend established by Chris Vanderhoven pre-covid.

Cath Williamson Loftus and Whitby (6th overall) was the leading female by the stille though negotiated in traditional fashion.

Harry Holmes continued to extend his lead as the race progressed to finish in 58 minutes, a lead of some 8 minutes but a couple of minutes shy of Matt Speake's 55

minute course record.

Sam Leadley Loftus and Whitby raced to second, there was debate at the finish line as to whether Andrew Collier Individual would of pipped Sam, as it was some dismay that the finish line crew noted a fast descending runner from Falconers Seat, sure enough it was Andrew Collier taking in a fifth peak.

In the teams competition, it was very close in the womens event with all three teams needing the contribution of a ghost runner and two points separating 1st and 3rd. On the day the youngest and oldest women, Rebecca Dent (1st U23) and Sue Haslam (1st V65) who made up the Scarborough AC team were awarded the prizes, when it was Pickering Running Club of Kelly Gaughan (3rd) and Serena Partridge (10th) who won in the final reckoning. NYMAC's Kirsty Struthers (4th) and Alison Lloyd (11th) were third team. Additional prizes next time. In a return to form it was Esk Valley Fell Club men, of Thomas Naisby (4th), Rorie McIntosh (7th), Martin Perry (14th) and Paul Cook (18th) from Pickering RC and NYMAC. Elsewhere in the results Kay Neesam (V55) was second female and 17th overall, Thomas Aspin was first male under 23 and Ben Senior TS Harriers first male veteran in 8th overall. Oldest runner in the race Scarborough's Neil Scruton was 51st overall.

With race prizes donated by Esk Valley Fell Club, race proceeds of £466 will be donated to the Rescue Team. Thanks to Sid Bolland's race organiser.

Winter Series 2021/22 presentations continued, with Kelly Gaughan, Sue Haslam, Katy Rawnsley and Joe Blackett receiving their awards.

Next race and barely time to gain breath is Cock Howe and Beyond at 19.15hrs on Wednesday 20th July, registration start and finish is at Chop Gate Village Hall.
