Comments:

It was a busy weekend for racing with plenty on offer for runners, the usual Saturday morning parkruns, an English Fell Championship counter at Whittle Pike, on Sunday the Middlesbrough 10km and the Hardmoors Roseberry trail race, plus others.

On Saturday it was the Tripsdale Trot Fell Race at Bilsdale Show, the show is a lovely event one of a cluster in August and September. The fell race is the tenth counter in the Dave Parry Lets Run Summer Fell Race Series 2025, so its very much the sharp end of the series, with lots still on offer in series plus of course the absolute joy of running on the North York Moors and a chance of wine, beer, cider, chocolate, sweets and maybe a bit of handmade pottery.

The weather is definitely on the turn, August is summer and September is the start of meteorological autumn, the show and runners were blessed with warm, sunnyish albeit a bit breezy conditions, the rain and stronger winds held off until the evening.

There were three races this year, the senior fell race, an out and back junior course for the under 9's and 11's of just under a kilometre and a longer Under 13's, 15's and 17's course of 2.50 kilometres, the U19's could run with the seniors over their 8.80 kilometre course.

A relatively modest field of 47 runners signed up for the longest race, they were treated to a fabulous course over some little run trails, note for next year everyone, thanks must go to David Sanderson Race Organiser, as well as the show committee who provided a grand prize list, plus the volunteers on course and at registration.

The main race set off to 'Chariots of Fire' played by the Bilsdale Silver Band and the applause of show goers just after 1.00pm, the field raced through the show field which had had a path cleared by stewards.

The early running was made by last years winner Ian Rowan (M45) Esk Valley Fell Club followed by Andrew Armin (MSEN) Saltwell Harriers and Paul Lawton (MSEN) Scarborough AC. Ester Harrison (FSEN) Thirsk and Sowerby Harriers led out the women with Natalie Greaves (F40) York Knavesmire Harriers closely following and then Sarah Fairhurst (FSEN) of Thirsk in third.

The leaders remained in close order to the high point of the race on Hagg House Moor, the descent through the Tripsdale Beck valley with its bracken and route choices was decisive allowing Paul Lawton to pull away and claim his maiden fell race victory and Esther Harrison claim her win.

Stephen Pugh (M55) Esk Valley Fell Club was the first over 50, David Hughes (M60) NYMAC first over 60 returning from injury and Geoffrey Usher (M70) Individual first over 70. In womens race Louise Mayfield (F50) Thirsk and Sowerby Harriers claimed first over 50 with Joanna Schreiber (F60) Pudsey and Bramley first over 60.

To the junior races where Cole Kendall and Georgiana Lanceley led home in the short junior race and William Rowan and Pippa Rowan both Esk Valley Fell Club led home in the longer junior race.

In the team competition Thirsk and Sowerby Harriers women and Esk Valley Fell Club men were the victors.

Next counter in the summer series is the penultimate event the Castleton Show Hilly Road Race aka a Road Race for Fell Runners and a Fell Race for Road Runners, with again short and long junior races for the various age categories, all to be held on Saturday 13th
